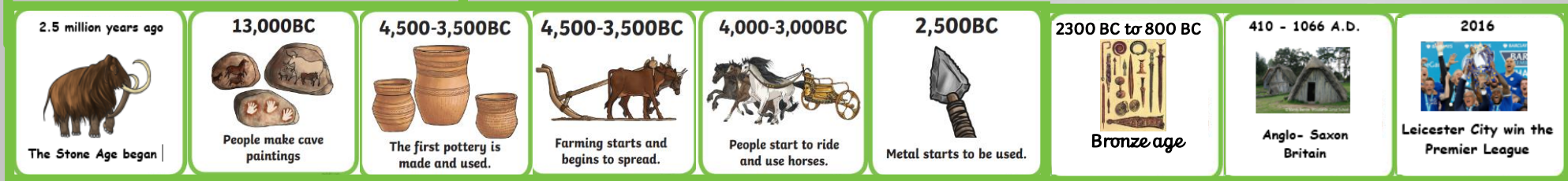

- Understand about hunter gatherers and what they ate

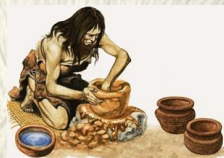
### Stone Age Enrichment Day

### Definition

<b>Prehistoric</b>	Pre-history - when humans first appeared.
<b>Agriculture</b>	Farming - Plants and livestock are grown for food.
<b>Palaeolithic</b>	The old Stone Age 2.5 million years ago to about 12,000 years ago.
<b>Mesolithic</b>	The middle Stone Age. About 12,000 years ago to about 10,000 years ago.
<b>Neolithic</b>	The new Stone Age. This was to about 6,500 years ago.
<b>Settlement</b>	A place where people live and build their home.
<b>Neanderthal</b>	The early form of humans.
<b>Nomadic</b>	People who lived travelling from place to place.
<b>Domestication</b>	Neanderthals gradually changed to modern humans.
