

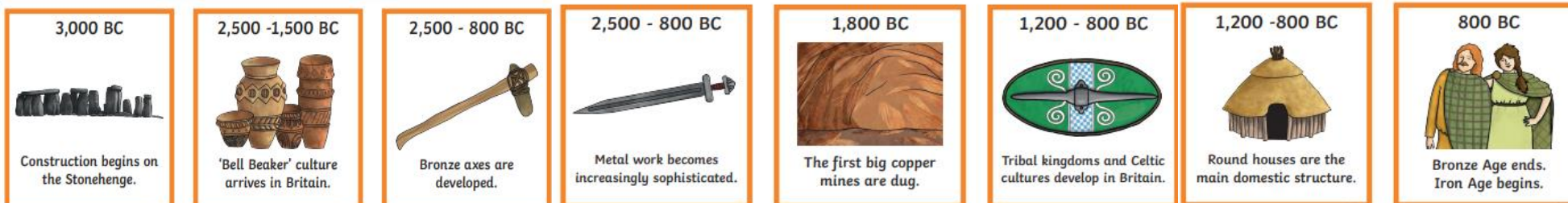
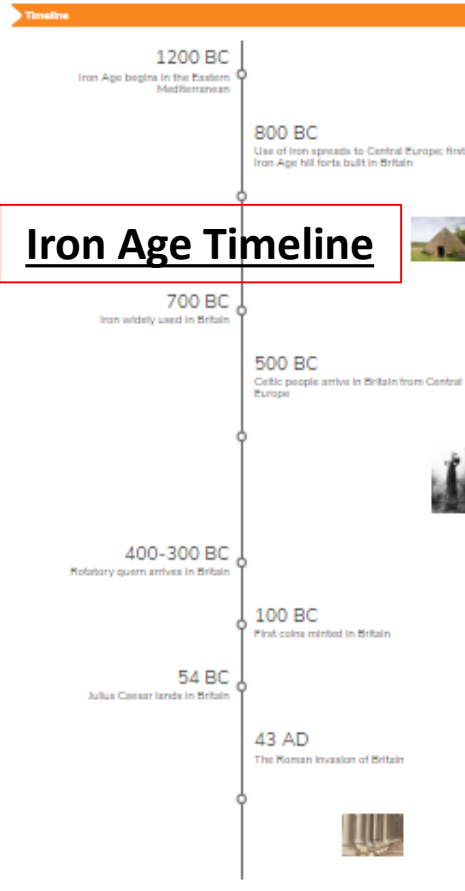

Prehistory	Period of time for which we have no written records
Bronze	Alloy of copper and tin
Alloy	A metal made by combining two or more metals to improve its properties
Beaker people	New arrivals to Britain named after their distinctive bell-shaped pottery
Roundhouses	Main domestic structure in n and Iron age
Celts	People living in Europe during the Iron Age
Smelting	Using a charcoal fired furnace to extract iron from iron ores
Hillforts	Defended settlements that made use of rises in the landscapes
Druids	Priests and religious leaders of the time
