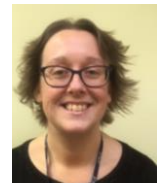
Headteacher's news

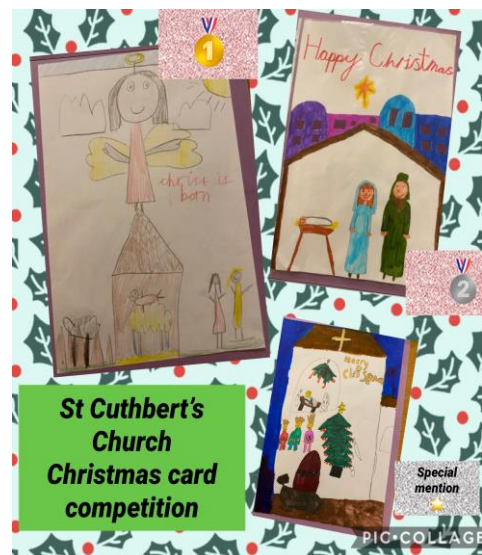
Christmas Card Competition

Covid-19 reminders

Face Coverings

A polite reminder- can **ALL** parents follow the request from the Director of Public Health and the Director of Children and Family Services, who **request that face coverings are worn by parents and carers at school pick up and drop off.**

Social distancing on the school site.

Please can ALL parents and visitors adhere to social distancing guidelines whilst on the school site- particularly when coming to collect children at the end of the day.

Latest Guidance

Please see the link below for the latest guidance from the NHS. If you have any of the main symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19), get a test as soon as possible. Stay at home until you get the result.

The main symptoms of coronavirus are:

- a high temperature - this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- a new, continuous cough - this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste - this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

Most people with coronavirus have at least 1 of these symptoms.

As the weather is getting colder and wetter, please ensure your child has a coat in school and suitable footwear for playing outside.

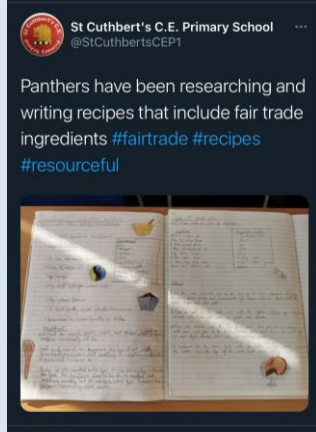


This year we are raising money to undertake the following projects:
