


Year 1 Knowledge Organiser - Term 1 Superheroes

History: I can...

- describe similarities and differences between the lives of people living in England and Scotland



Key Vocabulary

Country – land that is controlled by a single government.

Capital city - the city where the central government of a country is based.

Sea – an area of saltwater much smaller than an ocean.

Design and technology: I can...

- Sort fruit and vegetables by taste, shape, size, colour, texture and use basic tools to cut, shape and mix, e.g. cutters and whisks.



- use simple tools and materials with support.
- apply simple finishes e.g. paint, PVA glue glaze



Art: I can...

- use simple drawings and sketches to record my ideas, thoughts and feelings.
- use a wide range of tools to make marks, e.g. brushes, rollers, palette knife.
- talk about what happens when colours are mixed together.
