I hope that everyone is keeping well. We have been faced with a number of Covid cases within school over the last couple of weeks. This has been in children but also a number of staff have been affected (myself included for the second time) as well as staff absences due to other illness and circumstances.

Please know that everything possible is done to ensure consistently in teaching, provision and support for our children. This does occasionally mean that timetables have to change at short notice to ensure that every child receives the full curriculum. I apologise that it isn't always possible to communicate these changes ahead of time, but there are ways that you as parents can help support us. Here are a couple of suggestions:

- Children to have their reading books and knowledge organisers in school every day just in case we need to set homework, spellings or change books on a different day.
- PE kits to be in school on a **Monday morning** regardless of what day your child normally has PE. Kits can be taken home every Friday for washing if you wish. We often have extra sporting opportunities throughout the week so having their kit in school every day is helpful. Also if your child has an accident, spills something down them etc.., having something to change in to that is theirs makes children feel more comfortable.
