Covid- 19 reminders

What to do if your child develops symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) or tests positive for COVID-19

If your child develops symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19), they should get a **PCR test** and remain at home at least until the result is known. **If negative**, the child can end self-isolation; **if positive**, the child should isolate until at least 10 days after their symptoms appeared.

Symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are;

- a new, continuous cough,
- or a high temperature,
- or a loss of, or change in, their normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia).

In recent cases within school, children have shown symptoms of a stomach ache, head ache or a sore throat.

If the child has a positive test result but do not have symptoms, they should stay at home and self-isolate for 10 days from the date the positive test was taken.

Anyone with symptoms will be eligible for a PCR test (the normally available test type) and this can be arranged via Get a free PCR test to check if you have coronavirus (COVID-19) - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk) or by calling 119.

Health and Safety

A reminder that bikes or scooters must not be ridden in the playgrounds. This also includes younger siblings. On entering the school grounds, please push it to the bike shelter or scooter stand in the Key stage 2 playground or in the marked area through the side gate to the Key stage 1 playground. Do not ride bikes or scooters around the car park at any time.



Start of the day!

The school **opens at 8:50am** for children to start arriving. Some children in years 5 & 6, who walk to school on their own, are **arriving as early as 8:35am**. Parents will be contacted if this is the case as there is no staff member overseeing the playground at this time. Children arriving before 8:50am should be supervised by a parent or carer.
