This is so we can record the type of absence and support your child on their return. We appreciate this can be tricky at times, but it avoids absences being marked as unauthorised and staff having to follow up on this with your child.

We are aware that challenges over the past 2 years have resulted in families having to cancel, delay and rebook holidays with often limited choice on when to travel. Please ensure that you send a request in writing or email us with the information.

Please note that the Government legislation guidance schools follow in making these decisions, rarely agrees to parents taking their children out of school for the purposes of a holiday in term-time even after the disruption we have had. Holiday's in term time can result in Local Authority issuing fixed penalty notices.
