We would like everyone to dress as a word or a book character.

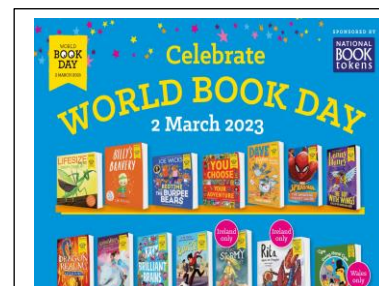

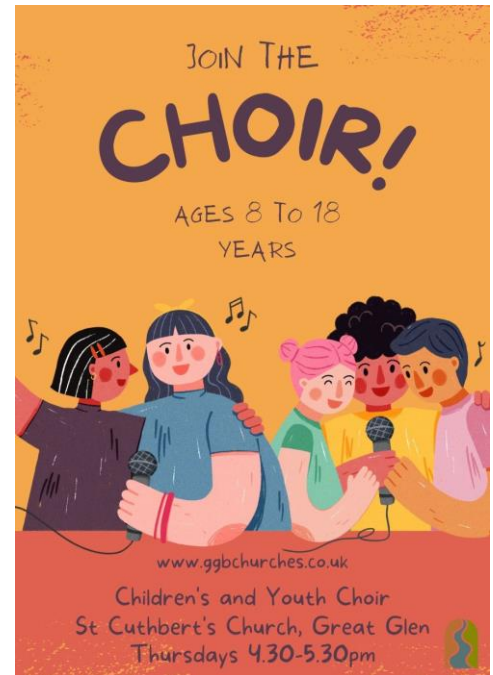
