Ofsted

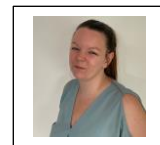

Attendance and Absence

It is vital for your child's education that they attend school regularly and promptly.

Please note that the Government legislation guidance schools follow in making these decisions, rarely agrees to parents taking their children out of school for the purposes of a holiday in term-time. Holiday's in term time can result in Local Authority issuing fixed penalty notices. Please ensure that you obtain an authorisation form from the school office or simply email us with the information.

Parking

Parents/ Carers who bring children to school by car must not:

- stop on the yellow lines outside the school entrance
- park on or in the school driveway/carpark

Children are expected to wear school uniform each day. Please see below suggested items that could be worn during the summer weather, with black shoes or trainers.

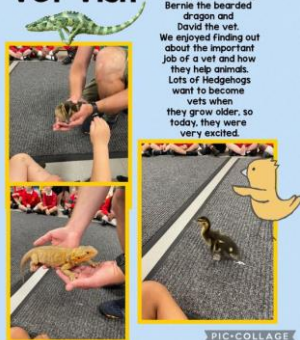
