Mrs Guy- SEND leader

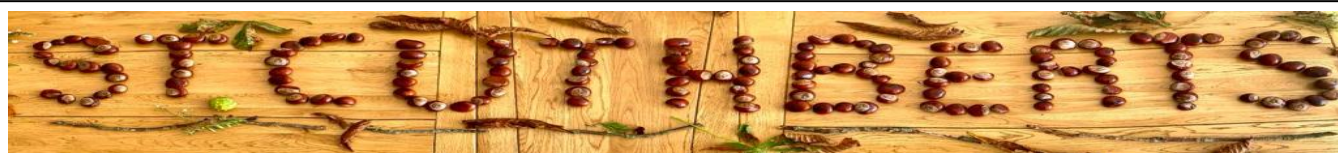
Mrs Hawkins will oversee the investigation process, supporting staff and children with interventions, if appropriate, to keep St Cuthbert's a safe and happy place of learning and enrichment.


