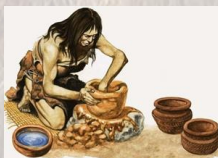
The Stone Age is the name given to the earliest period of human culture when stone tools were first used.

The new Stone Age. This was to about 6,500 years ago.
